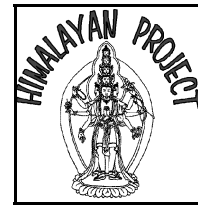

Tell about your Family and your Years of Growth :

I had a happy childhood until I was infected with tuberculosis 3 years ago. The TB infected both my hip- and knee-joints in my left leg, deforming the two joints completely, so I can not use my left leg at all as it is stiff. Now the pain has almost disappeared, so now I have started the school again in 6. class. I did spend half a year in hospital and almost a year in my bed, but I am not unhappy as this is my destiny. I am now completely recovered the doctors say. I will not be more sick again, but my leg will never change again.

Tell about Your Situation Now :

After next year when I have finished 7. class I will have to go for another school, as there is no higher classes in Sagar-Bakanje. But I will have to stay very close to my school, as I am only walking very slowly and not for long distances. But my father is a very good man and he is helping me a lot to do my best possible.

Tell about Your Plans for the Future (Long Term) :

How can I have great plans in my situation and in a poor family who can not afford giving me education. I really don't know what to think. But if it will be possible with help from outside, then I would like to be a teacher. Then I don't need to walk a lot, if I can be a teacher here in my home village. I hope to be an english language teacher in the future.

Give a Review about your Compulsory School Attendance until Now (Where, When and How Long) :

I have always attended Sagar-Bakanje Secondary School where my father is chairman of the School Committee. But my two years period of disease have until now broken my education, but now I am working hard to regain.

For which Purpose will You use Your Scholarship (Short Term) :

I would like after summer 2003 to go for Kathmandu to continue my secondary education in class 8-10 and later to join a campus for 11-12. class to be a teacher.

As it depends of the size of my scholarship I have not decided yet. But I will do in cooperation with my future donor.
