

## **Report of Chhimbu School, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2008**

### **Historical Background Of Chhimbu School**

This is Chhimbu Primary School, Situated in Solukhumbu District, one of very rural place of Nepal. The great economical help of Rotary Club of Denmark established this School with full involvement of Papa Kurt and people of this particular village in 1999. But formally, it was run from 17<sup>th</sup> June 2000 after having the permission of DEO.

In the beginning, only 38 students were enrolled in the school and 2 teachers were employed. It had 4 Rooms: an office room and 3 Classrooms and they were decorated with necessary furniture.

Rotary Club of Denmark had employed Mr. Jangbu Sherpa and Mr. Bhimshen Basnet as a teacher and had been paying their salary.

In 2003, School Management Committee (SMC) had proposed one additional teacher salary at Village Development Community (VDC), and VDC had provided one teacher salary for one year and Mr. Pemba sherpa was appointed for the post of teacher of the school and a year after Rotary Club of Denmark had paid his salary.

In 2004, District Education Office (DEO) employed Bimsen Basnet as headmaster of the school and has been paying his salary ever since. Last year DEO provided a nursery teacher and this year one more subsidy teacher for this school.

There are 3 teachers and 1 nursery teacher in this School. 1 Teachers are paying by Rotary Club of Denmark and and rest are being paid by DEO.

In the beginning of the 2007 this school employed a Nursery Teacher and one watchman provide by government for this School.

Now in total, this School have five staffs, including the peon, are servicing to run this School.

### **Outputs of this School (Achievements)**

In 2004-2008, 35 Students had passed the Class-5 from this School and went for their higher studies to other high Schools. Between them 2 students are studying in Class-10, 5 Students in Class-9 and others studying in Bakanje school in class 6, 7 and 8. Beside this School is progressing day by day. Students are also present in School regularly and studying well.

### **Presents Situation of this School**

With establishment of this school, there are growing on other developing activities. In the initial period, there were only 4 rooms in this School, but now it has built other 2 rooms by the help of Rotary club and VDC. In total it has now 6 rooms with comfort furniture in each room.

### **Importance of this School**

This School has its own meaning and importance. This School belongs to all those Students who were not able to go to School due to their lower economical condition and poor lively hood.

This School lies in Chhimbu Village, which is most back warded village than others. Most of villagers are the caste of thami who are also very poor and uneducated than other caste people. They don't have enough food to eat their living is very narrow they could not fulfill their basic needs. So they are not able to send their child to School to learn at that time. But now the condition is different even their living is same. And all these become success because of dear papa Kurt, Rotary club of Denmark and DEO, VDC.

Now the Children from this locality go to school regularly and learning well. If this school was not built at that time, the children may not get chance to study because other neighbors schools are very far away from this place. So all the credit of building this school goes to rotary club of Denmark and papa Kurt as well as all the co-donors.

### **Sustainability**

The sustainability of this School is very important for this locality. This School belongs to all the people who want to send their child to School but not being able to pay any fees of School, and all those Students who are searching their bright future.

If this School was not established, this village people never have a look the light of Education. They will be blind even though they got an eye. So, finally this School is the house of enlighten of education, knowledge, skill and art. Due to this all the people of this village wish to have this School alive here forever and we all believe that, in near future, there will be no one who is beyond the education.
