They were studying at school when we start providing scholarship to Ram but unfortunately about 3 years ago they become disabled from the same day. Now they can't move from one place to another and their legs are very small and weak. Their are four members in their family, the twins, their younger brother and mother. The father don't stay with them because he has a new wife and child at Phaplu. But sometimes he use to visit them so as a result Ram's mother is now pregnant and she is going to give a birth of new member in the poor family. They are living in small house and they don't have land and any animals. So, the mother use to work hard for others and get some food and money to maintain their livelihood.

On 8th April morning, I reached the house of Ram



at Phalamkhani where he is living with his family. It was a small house and I peeped from the door but I couldn't see anybody inside the house and when I tried to move off then I heard the sound of whispering.

Again, I tried to see inside then I saw the twins were sitting in the dark corner of the house nearby the fire.



Then, I entered into the house and asked them about the mother but they didn't reply me. When I went near by them to have some pictures then, suddenly I saw the horrible wound on right knee of Laxman. I only heard that he was in fire about six months ago but never I imagined that much serious. It was really awful and flies were flying inside the room and around them. I spent around half an hour by taking some pictures and waiting for their mother.

When the mother came to her younger son with some firewood then I started to talk about the Laxman's wound. According to her about six months ago when she was out for work at that time he rolled down in the fire and was there for about half an hour then he was rescued by the neighbor but it was too late because his right hand and leg was burnt, then the mother took him to Phaplu Hospital. The wound from his hand was cured but the wound on his leg was not healing at the Hospital so he was sent back to their house. And they don't have any option for treatment rather than staying at home. So, day by day the wound is becoming worse and worse instead of healing. I found that they use to cry almost all nights with pain of wound and pain in their knees.

Later, I knew that they use to speak very little with each other and with the family members. I really wanted to speak and listen to them so, I tried to show some pictures of them and their family.

Then, they started to react on photos whether they are nice or not. Finally, I handover scholarship money to Ram and he was very happy to get it.



At last, before I leave I talked to the mother about the donor interest in Ram but I didn't dare to assure them about anything.

After I visited Ram's family I found that it is really difficult life for them because they don't have proper warm clothes to wear so that they have to sit very close to fire all the time. They didn't have a proper bed to sleep in and mat to sit on as well as nothing in the kitchen for eating.
