DEO building

It is under process of reconstruction. DEO has recently (After he received HP report) visited Pikey School. He has, immediately, suspended the last installment transfer Rs.50.000 to school account after he has seen the quality of the roof. He has assured School management committee that he would release the fund when reproofing is satisfactorily completed. He also promised of Rs.52.000 additional support for the same purpose if they could show the quality of work.
