Principal and teacher is Jangbu Sherpa from Chhumbu He has 4 years of teacher's practise from Sagar-Baganje School He is experienced in administration Teacher is Bimsen Bashnet from Kenja He has some experience from Sagar-Baganje and Kenja School

38 students have admitted Chhumbu Primary School in the year 2000/200123 students started in first class15 students started in second class

60 students is expected to admit the school for the year 2001/2002

On this basis Chhumbu Primary School do comply with government's criteria's to supply the school with one teacher From many sides there shall be done every effort to have one government teacher from next year Rotary will still provide 2 teachers for next year, so there should be 3 teachers in year 2001/2002

It should be possible to obtain one more government teacher for the year 2002/2003 In this case Rotary will provide 1 teacher, so there will still be 3 teachers

If Government will not provide this second teacher, it has to be negotiated with Rotary how far they shall provide more than 1 teacher

In July 2003 Rotary will end its donations for Chhumbu Primary School, and the school has to be run by

Government, the villagers and by own means

30 sets of textbooks is delivered for 1. class, consisting of 4 books each set

30 sets of textbooks is delivered for 2. class, consisting of 5 books each set

But the children of 2. class is of a higher level than their book, so 20 sets of 2.class senior level will be delivered

There is 2 months of vacation each year, which can be parted between summer and winter after the wish of the school, and there will be 3-4 weeks of vacation during Dasain and Tihar every autumn The teachers will have full salary during vacation, and there will be one month extra salary during Dasain

Negotiation about teachers salary:

From the beginning of the work on the school at 20. June 2000 the salary will be:

The salary will be paid every 3 month after finishing the 3 months work – the payment days will be:

Jangbu Sherpa started his work on the school on 20. June 2000

Bimsen Bashnet started his work on the school on 17. July 2000

He had 15 days of full paid leave caused to his father's death from 1. September till 18. September
