Observation Report SagarDanda School Building Construction 01. May 2009

Two naked building, containing two rooms each, construction is completed and is ready to put roof on. The quality of construction is very high. Also quality of the timber and stone used for the contraction is very good. Construction Committee has bought tin roof in Katmandu and they are transported to Bandar by truck. According to Committee roofing will have been done before summer is started. Mr. Loknath Pudel, District Education Officer has visited the site recently and became proud of the construction work villagers have performed. After seeing the quality of the construction he immediately promised of one additional building with two rooms, one for office and other for classroom. For that purpose DEO will give Rs.550,000 which is only for naked building construction.

I had meeting with DEO before and after my visit Sagardanda School Construction site. We talked about the construction and interior decoration with furniture in tree buildings. He informed me about additional building and said agreement between DEO and School will be done very soon. He told me that he can't go for inside project as DEO has no money for the purpose. He wants HP to take over for project. this He also expressed his gratitude to HP for helping him in education field.



At the project site, I met Construction Committee Member and Villagers; they had same opinion as that of DEO. They have humble request to HP for the interior decoration.

For the additional building construction school doesn't have land. So they are planning to request former land donor for the necessary land. They are pity much sure that school will get a land from the former donor.
