A brief introduction

Founded in 1996 with the initiative of a group of academic professionals, with recognition from Ministry of Education, Unique Boarding High School has been imparting knowledge and skills encouraging the students to deal with the challenges of practical and life long education. Located in peaceful settings of Siphal, Chabahil, Kathmandu, we provide a homely atmosphere, which contributes to enhance the academic achievements as well as extra curricular activities. Even students with limited resources can achieve quality education with the moderate school fees.

Our pedagogical purpose is not only to teach the curriculum's subjects but also the child. Our teaching staffs are dedicated in developing the personality of students, socially, morally and intellectually. We take into consideration the learner, the learning process and the learning situation. Our syllabus and textbooks are adequate to enable the students become cultured and useful members of the society. Moreover, having realized the growing demand of the modern era, we have introduced computer software; project based teaching and additional input to English language.

Based on the overall performance including the management of the school, Unique Boarding High School has been awarded A-grade standard certification by the Government of Nepal a year before and we feel proud that our efforts have been recognized and appreciated. Only a few schools in Nepal fall under this coveted grade.

Scholarship

Unique School has scholarship policy for poor and talented students and the students from the disadvantaged groups. The school management is keen to provide fees waiver to the class toppers. If the student is the third member of the same family, s/he has been getting 100% tuition waiver. The first child of any staff of Unique School is given full fees waiver and the second child is given 50% waiver in the total fees. Moreover, persons and organizations have become generous to support poor and intelligent students. Himalayan Project, Denmark, Educate the Children (ETC), Nepal and Xavier Gasseo, Spain have contributed to educate some students at Unique Boarding School. The school has been exploring other possibilities to acquire support for the needy students.

Unique School looks forward to your support

Despite the academic excellence, facilities and services and the Category of the school, the fee structure is moderate. The school has set up a small library, science and computer lab with unlimited internet services to the students by allocating 14 computers. We have experienced that the students are very keen to use the library books and they have also proved that use of library has helped them enhance their reading habits with analytical skills; the junior students enjoy reading pictorial books, want to use dictionaries and read different types of books. Moreover, the Grade 8, 9 & 10 syllabi demand basic lab-based experiment in science (biology, physics and chemistry). For School Leaving Certificate (SLC) examination, 25 % evaluation is based on the practical lab-based experiments performed by the students. But because of the lack of adequate financial resources, it is not possible for the school to procure additional library books and science equipments. Only the option is to increase the school fees which many of the guardians cannot afford.

I, therefore, on behalf of Unique Boarding High School, propose you to support to achieve our goal for developing the school library and science lab so that many students from working class family would be benefited who would otherwise be deprived of facilities for quality education.
