Himalayan Project Nepal (HIPRON) is Social welfare non-governmental organization (NGO), established in March 2007, initiated by Himalayan Project Denmark (HP-DK) with the aim of bringing the great change in the field of education in Nepal, especially in upper Solu of Nepal by making HIPRON as the authorized organization of HP-DK in Nepal and launch the various project through it by HP-DK itself and other Danish organizations who want to involve in the development field of Upper Solu with HP-DK.

With the great effort of HP-DK, HIPRON was legally registered with the District Administrative Office of Katmandu, affiliated with social welfare council, Ministry of Social Welfare, and also has been registered with the Government Revenue Tax office lazimpat-3, which has been conducting educational and various social development projects mainly in Upper Solu, eastern part of Nepal, to uplift the educational standard of the backward community by giving opportunity of education to their children who are living under darkness of illiterate and poverty.

HIPRON has been serving to the poor, needy and intelligent students who are studying in Solukhumbu, and the students, from Solu, who are studying in Katmandu for the further studies to make their future bright with the support of Danish kind-hearted donor. Moreover, HIPRON has a regular runner service that provides the service to Danish Rotary Clubs, HP-DK and other concern donor organization who are working in the field of development in Solu through HP. HIPRON Runner Provides service for the donor as well as beneficiary group are: monitoring the projects, reporting to the donor about the projects, exploring potential projects, providing information to the donor about the circumstances, Scholarship distribution, letter distribution to the scholars and letter collection from students for their donor, checking scholars progress and regularities of the scholars. The services Runner provides are very much based on reality and validity in reliable price.

HIPRON Runner visits Solu (Project site) once every three months and during the visit Project monitoring and checking will be carryout and prepared the reports for the donors. Runner also plays the role of facilitator between donors and the project stakeholders to make things happen. The main aim of the HIPRON Runner Service is to give the best and faster service to the both donors and project beneficiary groups in a reliable manner.
